Special features of the Academy include early childhood, intensive and boys divisions, as well as performance opportunities that allow students to gain theatre experience. Academy students can audition for roles in company productions such as The Nutcracker and Cinderella for the chance to perform alongside BalletMet's professional dancers. For advanced students, the Academy also offers an intensive, pre-professional trainee program. Trainees dance 30-40 hours weekly and are selected through audition. Trainees may have the opportunity to dance in Company productions.
